



The current system was designed to allow physicians to log into the portal which brings the physician to the patient list and the list of action items. The physician can either select a patient or an action item. If an action item is selected, he/she will be taken to that particular page (i.e. An action item may be a POC change that needs to be 'signed' by the physician. Selecting this will take them to the POC page.) If a patient is selected from the patient list then the physician will be able to view patient data within the other portlets. If the physician attempts to click on one of the other pages without first selecting a patient from the patient list, they will see a 'Please select a patient' message displayed with the portlet. All of this is architected, developed and deployed to be compliant with HIPPA standards.
